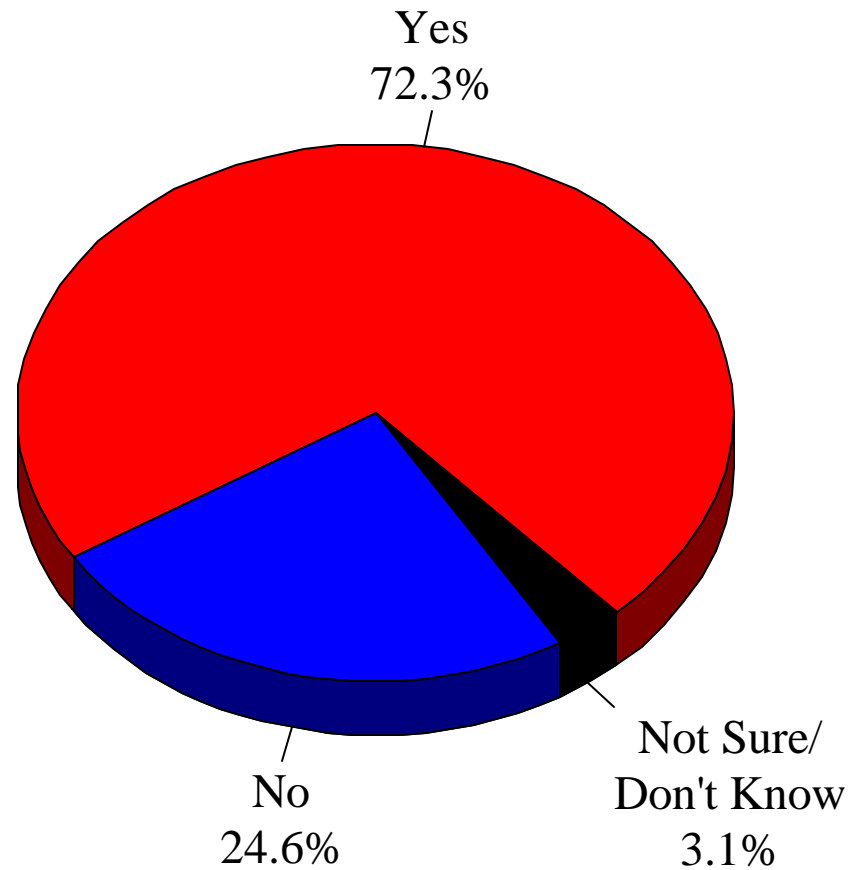


## Ohio Poll, October 1999

"Do you feel you know what a developmental disability is?"

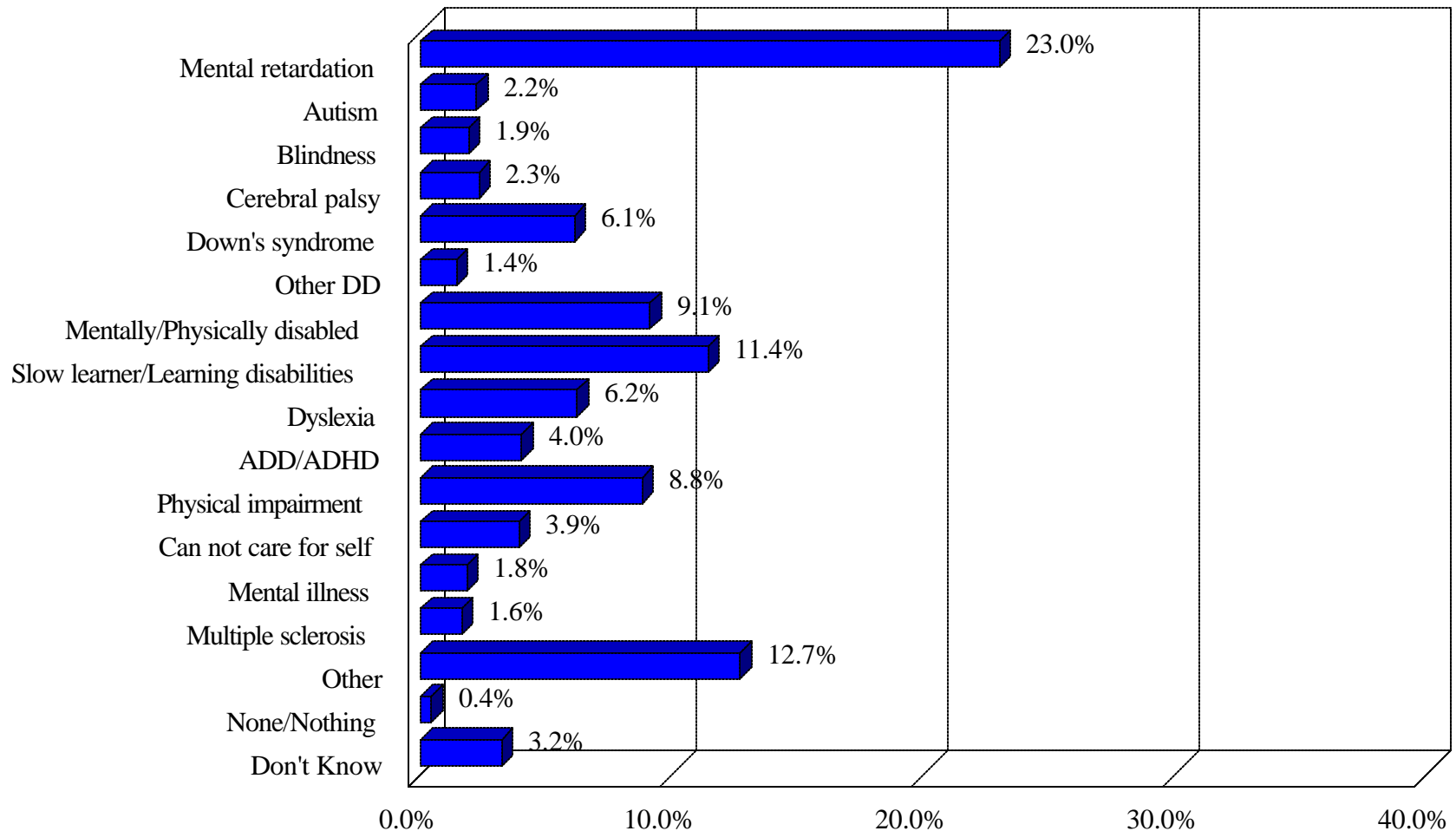

what developmental disability comes to mind?"

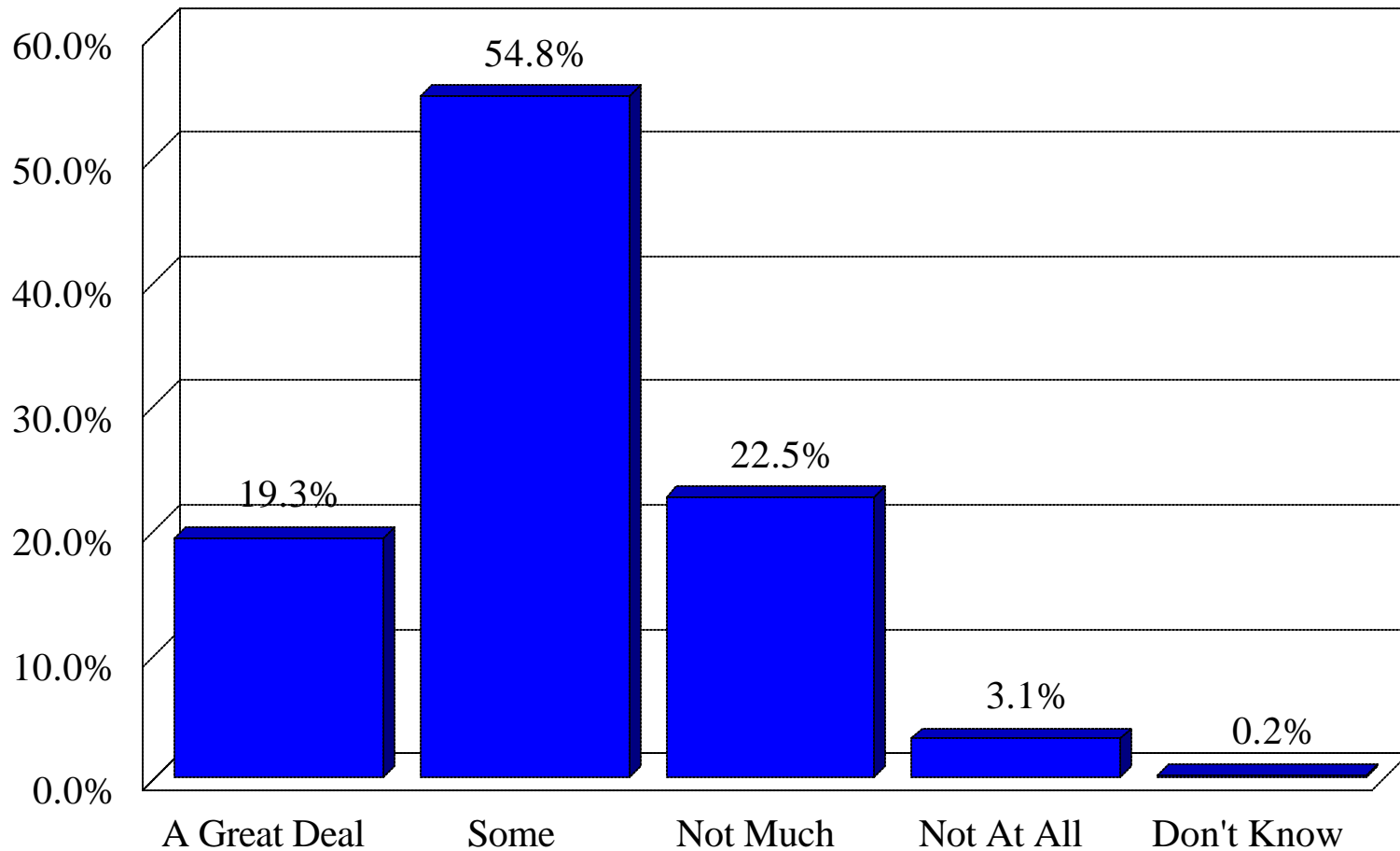
(Asked of respondents who say they know what a developmental disability is.)

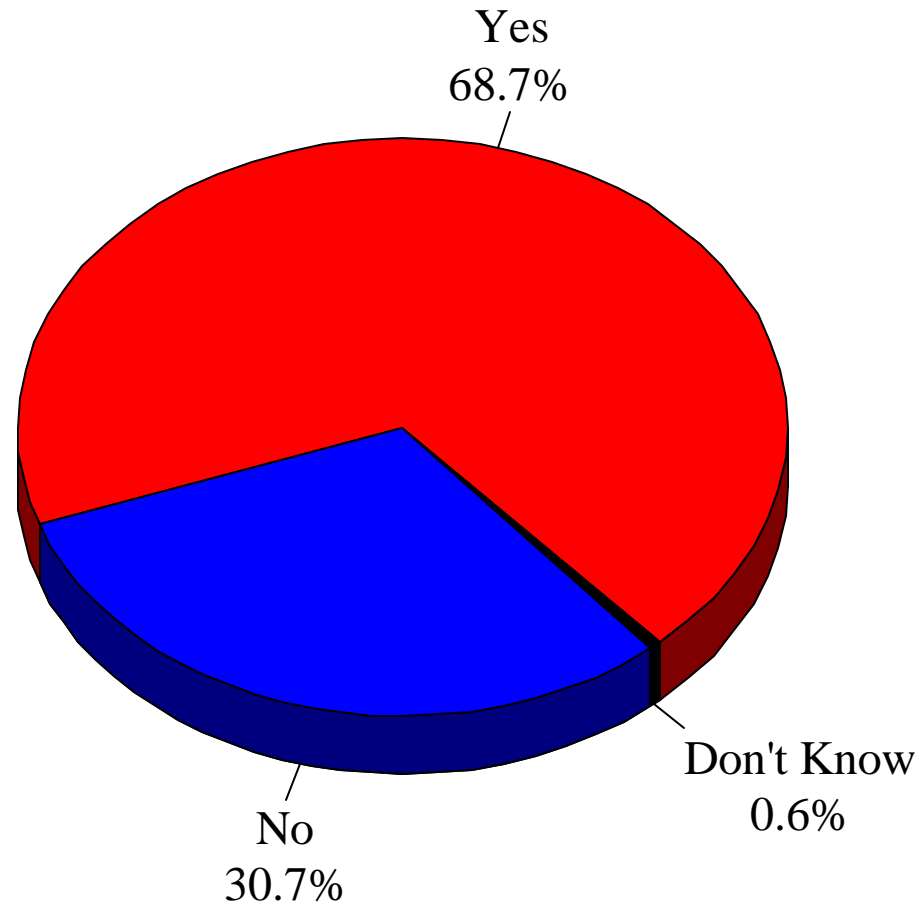
"Overall, how much do you feel you know about people with developmental disabilities . . . ?"

"Do you personally know anyone with a developmental disability?"

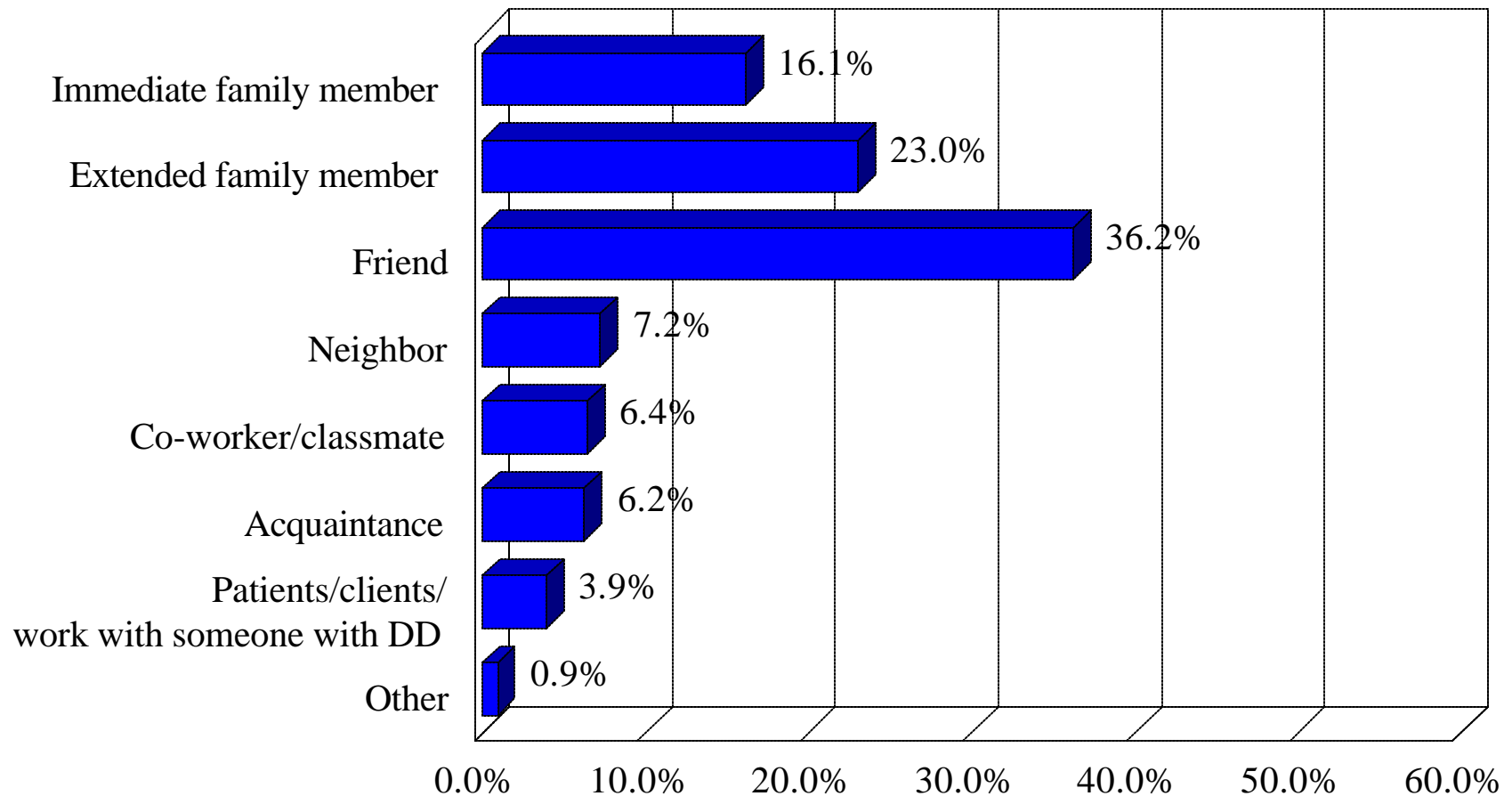

"What is your relationship to this person?"

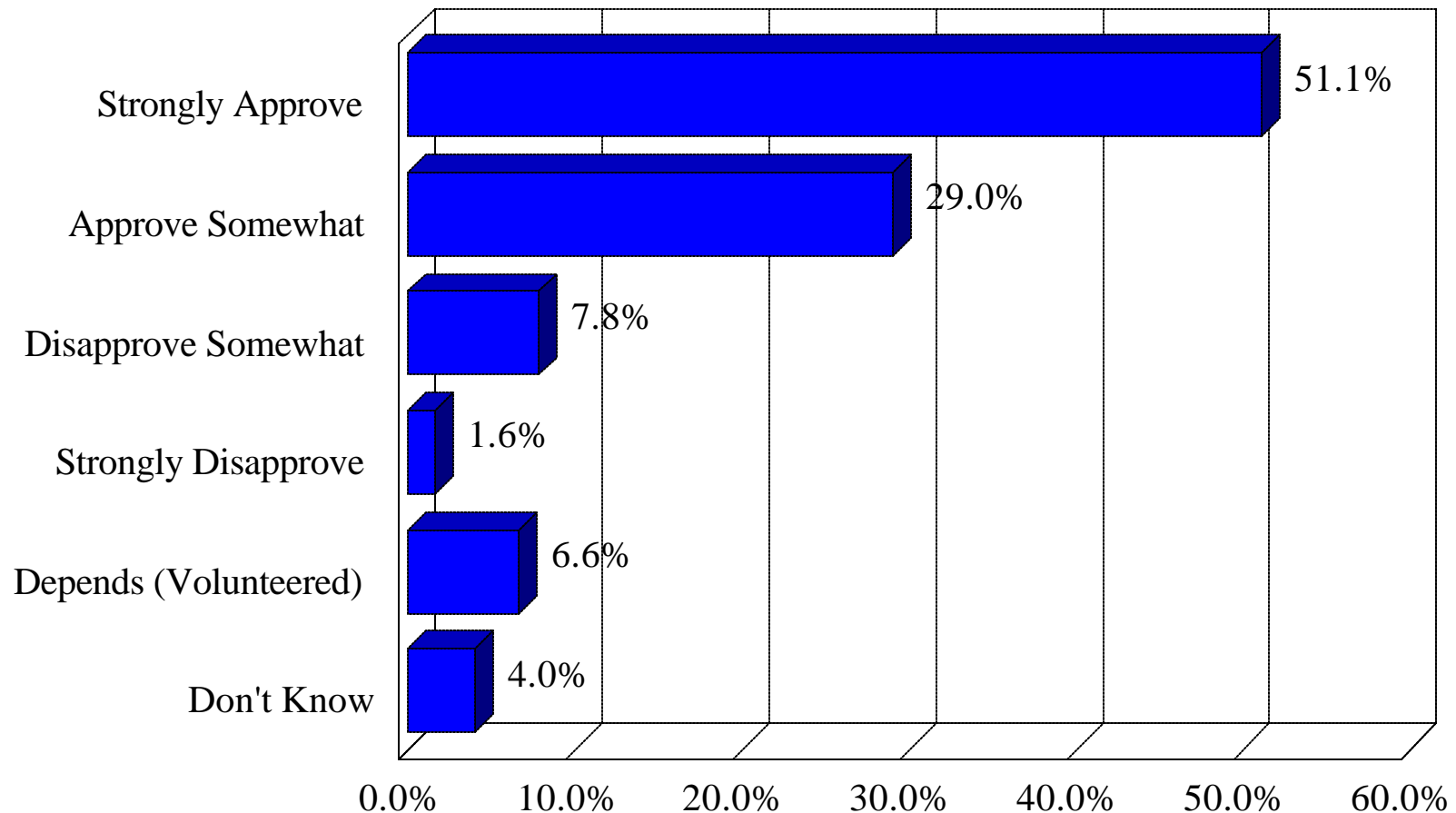
(Asked of respondents who say they personally know someone with developmental disabilities.)

Approve:

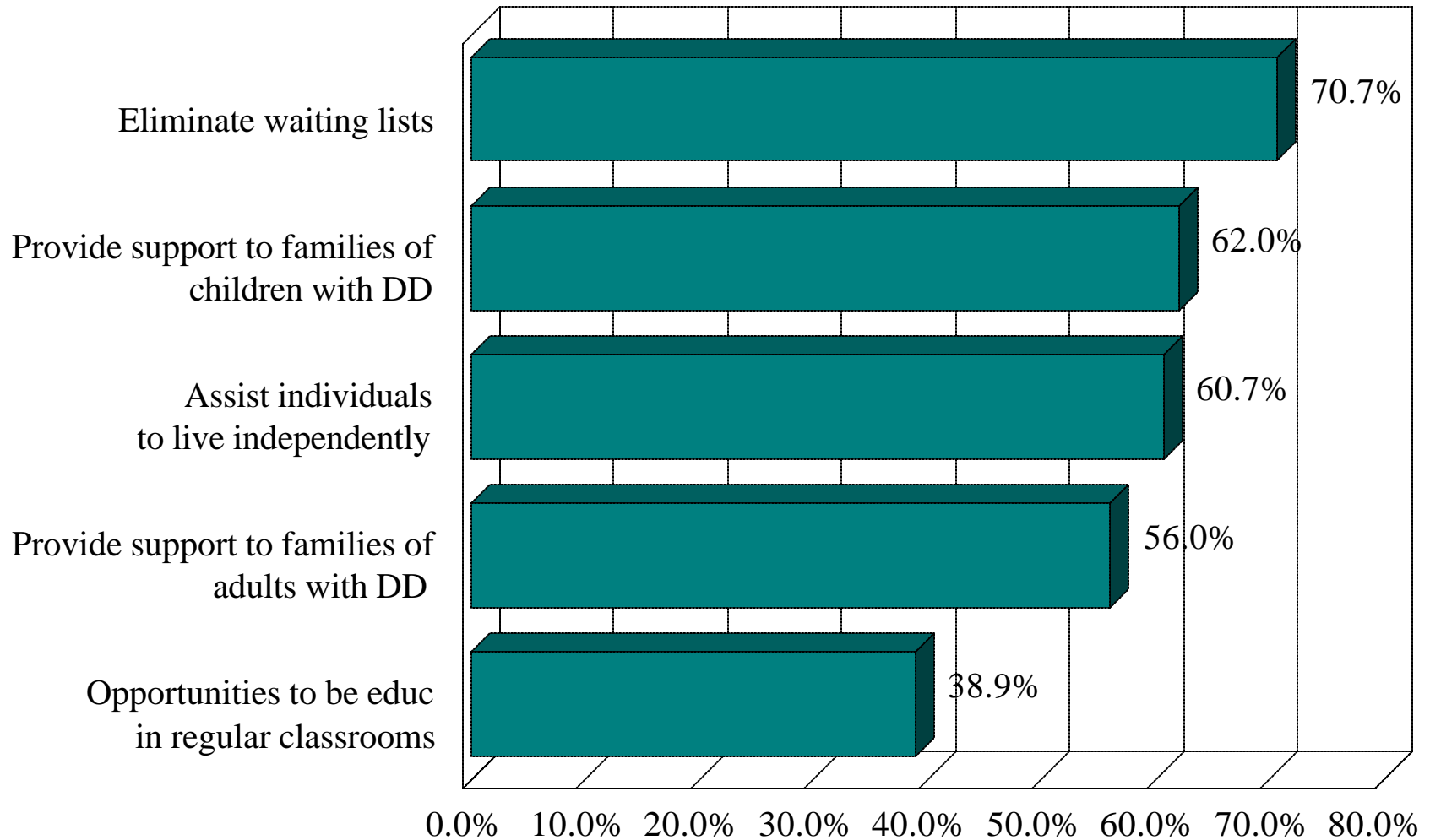
They need help / need support	23.6%

Programs are already sufficiently funded	1.2

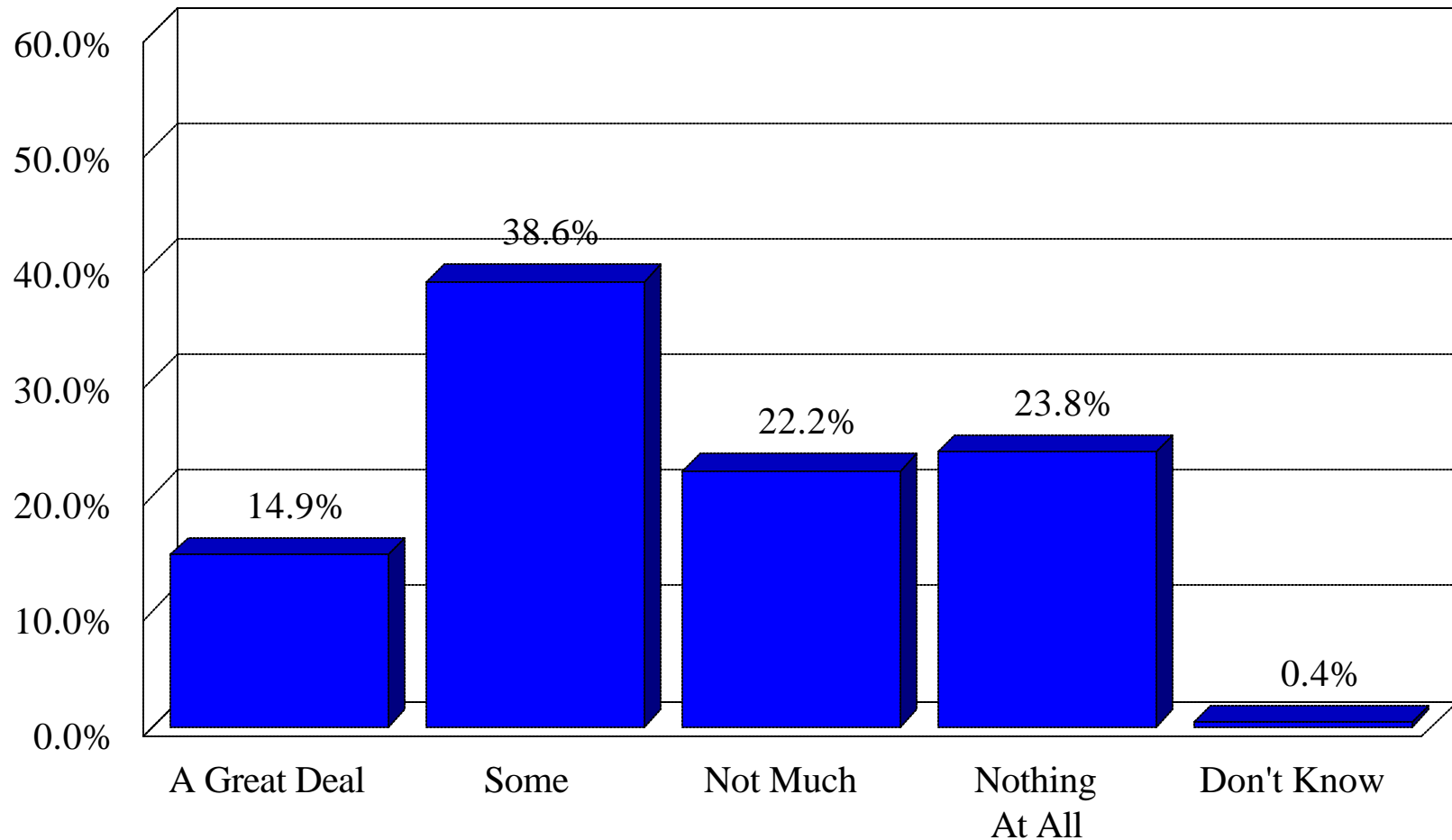

"Have you heard or read about integrating people with developmental disabilities into communities, workplaces and schools?"

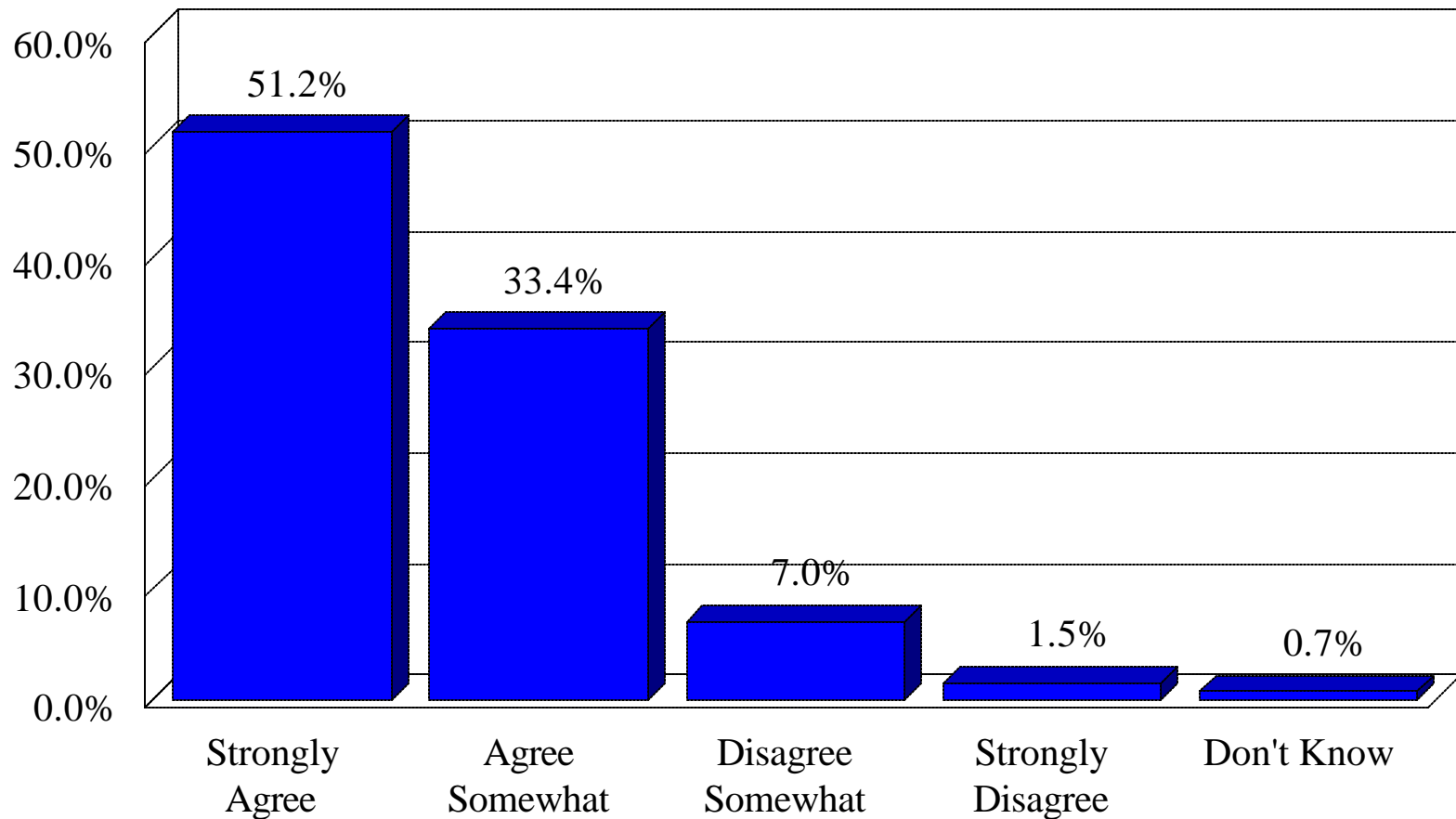

# The Ohio Poll October 1999

## Survey Methodology

Interviews were conducted by telephone with 870 Ohio adult residents.

Interviews were conducted between October 13 and November 2, 1999.

The potential sampling error for the survey is +/- 3.3%.

# ODDC mail survey

## April 2000

### Survey Methodology

Surveys were mailed on March 24, 2000 to 1,005 individuals in the State of Ohio.

Surveys were sent to individuals who were identified as government officials, individuals and family members of people with developmental disabilities, MRDD board members and personnel, and disability advocacy groups.

A total of 341 surveys were returned by April 24 and included for analysis.
